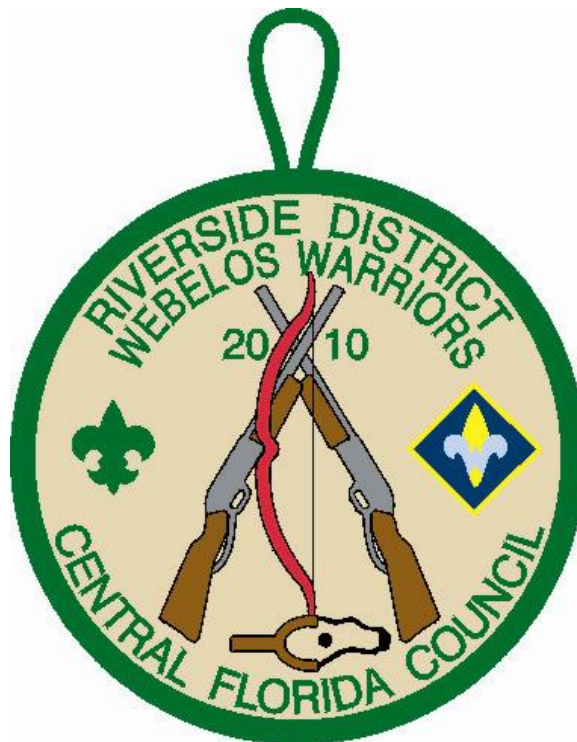

# Webelos Warriors

## 2010

This weekend activity is designed to enhance the Riverside District Webelos Program. Many of the scouts look forward to attending the annual Webelos Woods event because it gives them an opportunity to participate in an event exclusive to them. Webelos Warriors will give the Webelos one more opportunity to be excited about scouting! The scouts love the shooting sports! They only have the opportunity to do Archery and BB's at District and Council sponsored events. These opportunities are few and far between. By attending this event, they will have one more opportunity to do the activities that they love. New this year is the option of camping with their Webelos Den.

This activity is being chaired by René Waldrop and Eddie Waldrop, trained Webelos Leaders and Central Florida Council Rangemasters. Mr. Waldrop is also a NRA certified instructor for Basic Pistol, Basic Shot gun and Basic Rifle. The staff will consist of Central Florida Council Certified Rangemasters, and registered Boy Scouts, serving as Range Assistants throughout the Riverside and Challenger Districts. Safety is our first concern!

The event is open for all Webelos Scouts currently registered in the Central Florida Council and will be heavily promoted in Brevard County. It is not available for Scouts registered at other levels. Tigers, Wolves, Bears and siblings will not be allowed to participate in the activities. Webelos Leaders and Parents of Webelos Scouts are encouraged to attend. By keeping this event limited to only Webelos, we will have the opportunity to teach more in depth skills to them. This will improve their self confidence as well as their love of scouting.

Webelos Warriors offers a variety of shooting sport events, including Archery, BB guns, Wrist Rockets and Marshmallow Shooters. We will begin the day with an Opening Ceremony including a Flag Ceremony, Patrol Rally and Instructions for the day. After the Webelos Scouts have rotated through the Shooting Sports there will be an opportunity to purchase lunch from the grill. Our Midway will be packed with displays from a variety of Boy Scout Troops from the Riverside District, giving the Webelos and their parents the opportunity to interact with the Troops and get to know them. The afternoon will be free time giving each Webelos Patrol the chance to work together on accomplishments or just have supervised free time. You will be able

to plan and cook your evening meeting with your patrol. Later we will have a Campfire Program and you will be able to provide the camp with entertainment in the form of approved skits, songs and such.

Pre-registration and payment is **required** for this event. Registration forms will be located on the Central Florida Council Website, at the Brevard Scout Shop and available at Roundtable meetings. Online registration will be available at the Central Florida Council website. Once the forms are completed, they can be turned in to Reneé Waldrop, the event chair via drop off at the Brevard Scout Shop, in person at Eagle District Roundtables or via email. Fees may be made payable in the form of cash or check made out to the Central Florida Council. Credit card payment will be handled through the online registration.

The cost of this event is \$15 per Webelos Scout and adult. The cost of the event is the same whether you camp or not...so take advantage of the opportunity to camp! Each Webelos Scout registered will receive a commemorative patch.

Promotional visits to Pack Meetings and/or Den meetings will be available at the request of Webelos Den Leaders in our District.

A Webelos Den/Patrol from the District will be invited to provide the Opening Flag Ceremony. A different Webelos Den will be invited to provide the Closing Flag Ceremony.

Class A or Field uniforms are required for the Opening and Closing Ceremonies. Class B or Activity uniforms are acceptable for the remaining events. All Scouts must wear appropriate footwear, ie no open toes shoes. It is highly recommended that each Scout have a water supply available to them to maintain proper hydration. Sunscreen and bug repellent are also recommended.

There will be no profanity, smoking, alcohol or controlled substances during the event. Adult smoking areas will be provided away from the Scouts if necessary. All Webelos Scouts, leaders and accompanying parents will be asked to behave in a "Scout Appropriate" manner throughout the event. All shooting range safety guidelines will be followed. Anyone who does not follow these simple rules will be asked to leave the event. Camp site locations will be provided as close to the parking area as possible. There will be no vehicles allowed in camp with the exception of a brief period for the Boy Scout Troops to set up and break down their displays.

Due to the inability to provide youth and adult shower areas (Youth Protection Rule), the showers will be **closed** for the weekend. **NO SHOWERS. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
